Supervision

Please know that your son/daughter will be supervised by dedicated adults that have been with the program for many years. These adults donate much of their time to develop Junior Cadets and give them as much positive influence and experiences as possible.

Activities

The Junior Cadets will participate in many events during the course of the training year. We go orienteering, hiking, snow tubing, mountain biking, to name few. We will hand out permission forms prior to each event so please ask your child about the forms. Also, please be advised that if your son/daughter does not have their health card and signed permission slip with them, they will not be able to participate in the trips (no exceptions).

This information is also available on our website (www.2824cops.com). Once all of your son/daughter's paperwork is handed in, I suggest they attend as many events as possible, as it will only heighten their experience in Junior Cadets. Many times these are free or have a very low cost.

Commitment
